




Compared to 2010:

55% OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV RECEIVE ANTIRETROVIRAL TREATMENT (ARV) 23 points higher than in 2010

> LATIN AMERICA HAS ONE OF THE HIGHEST COVERAGE IN THE WORLD FOR THE HIV **TREATMENT**



88% OF PREGNANT WOMEN LIVING WITH HIV RECEIVE ARV TREATMENT **36** points higher than in 2010 8% OF CHILDREN LIVE WITH HIV DUE TO MOTHER-TO-CHILD TRANSMISSION 7 points lower than in 2010

50,000 **AIDS-RELATED DEATHS 17%** less than in 2010



490,000 CHILDREN AGES 0-17 ARE AIDS ORPHANS 16% less than in 2010
